

Milton Sterilising Tablets

1 Tablet = sterilise in 15 minutes

Function :

Babies are at their most vulnerable, whilst they are developing their immune system, so it is important that feeding utensils are sterilised thoroughly until they are at least 12 months old.

Milton has been sterilising babies feeding utensils for over 50 years and is clinically proven to protect your baby from all germs (bacteria, viruses, fungi).

The Milton solution leaves no unpleasant taste or odour, so there is no need to rinse after use - utensils can be use immediately.

Each solution lasts for 24 hours

Physico-chemical characteristics :

Texture : tablets

Colour : white

Fragrance: chlorine

pH at 20°C

(for 1 tablet dissolved in 5L of tap water) = 6.5 +/- 0.5

Directions for use :

1) Clean utensils thoroughly after each feed

Clean carefully the baby's bottles and teats with a warm soapy water. Rinse with cold water.

2) Prepare Milton Solution

Fill your Milton Sterilising Unit, or similar Unit with cold water. For every 5 L of water add 1 Milton tablet.

3) Completely immerse utensils

Ensure that no air bubbles are trapped inside the bottles/utensils. Items are ready to use after 15 minutes or can be left for 24 until you need to use them again. Wash your hand before removing utensils from the solution. Drain bottle and teats – no need to rinse. Fill bottle immediately and cover teats.

Micrological activity :

- Bactericidal : EN1040 in 1 mn, EN1276 in 5 mn.
- Fungicidal : EN1275 in 1 mn, actif on Candida Albicans (thrush)
- Virucide : Actif sur fatrovirus Polio 1, Adenovirus type 5, Rotavirus (gastroentérite) A/H1N1 (swine flu)

Active ingredient: sodium dichloroisocyanurate (CAS: 2893-78-9):19.5% m/m
